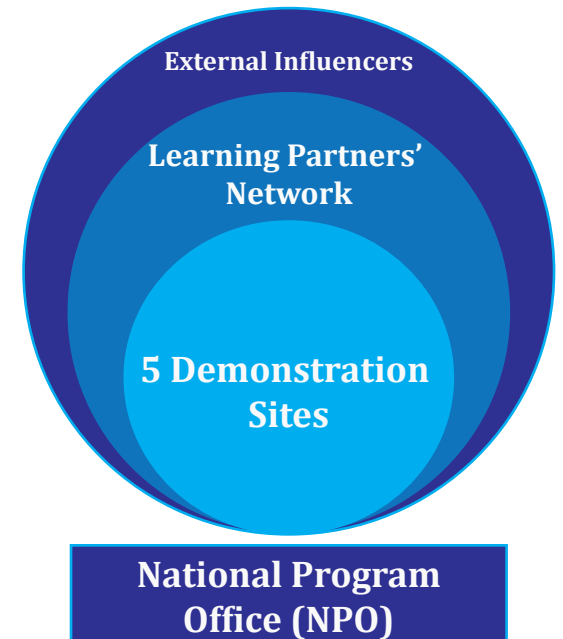

Goal 1: Increase the quality and use of data in university strategic and action planning to improve the health workforce

- 1.1 Identify characteristics of institutions that enable strong performance
- 1.2 Assist demonstration sites in assessing and improving capacity for evidence-based decisions
- 1.3 Identify and grade evidence for educational strategies
- 1.4 Develop a capacity assessment tool for universities

Goal 2: Identify measures to assess progress and drive greater impact

- 2.1 Identify community-level health workforce outcomes for target communities
- 2.2 Work with sites to establish institution-wide goals in the core areas
- 2.3 Identify measures that enable institutions to manage progress
- 2.4 Determine the need for data, and identify data resources, gaps, and potential solutions
